QUALITIES OF SIR WALTER

Sir Walter is known for its shade tolerance and is able to handle 70% shade, which is more than most other varieties. During the Winter months most lawns will tend to lose colour and look as though the lawn has died off, however Sir Walter has the ability to maintain colour and coverage during this period of time, providing all necessary care has been adhered to. With Sir Walter you will find that having a tight growth habit of the roots it will hold out most weeds and common grasses that may be present, making your life that little bit more stress free.



RECOMMENDED CARE REQUIREMENTS

- Mowing height is approximately 40mm
- During Summer mow every 1-2 weeks
- During Winter mow every 2-3 weeks
- Fertiliser is generally 2-4 applications a year
- Full sun, handles approximately 70% shade
- Low water usage, still recommended to water regularly
