 - 10% Washed Sand

Generous levels of nutrients and trace elements for your garden's long term health including a healthy amount of iron, calcium and magnesium among many other elements required for strong, healthy plants.

- ❖ Unlike less expensive manufactured soils with very high organic content, the high sandy loam content in Nuway's 5 Star Gold Label Soil ensures your garden bed soil level will not drop as much when the compost material breaks down as it is a heavier, denser soil than most. You won't need to top up as much next year, saving you money in the long run!
- ❖ Saves water as superior permeability, wettability and water retention means every drop is more efficiently used with far less waste. Cheaper soils can more easily become hydrophobic, repelling water rather than soaking it in. This can prevent moisture from reaching where it's needed most: the roots.
- ❖ Do you like to see the results, not just the words? At Nuway, SO DO WE! Our own in house tests with tomato plants show noticeably stronger growth rates, colour, general health and yields against other soils tested (including our own alternatives). CARING FOR YOUR GARDEN – PLANTS AND SOIL:

- ❖ With any garden soils, mulching is highly recommended. Direct sunlight can cause a water repellent crust on the surface and excessive radiant heat around your plants. Mulch and compost is the most natural way to keep your plants cool and moist. Mulching is also the best way to reduce nasty weeds.
- ❖ During prolonged dry periods even frequent brief showers may not be enough to penetrate your soil and mulch to get to the roots. It is important to check how dry your soil and mulch is beneath the surface. It may look wet even after a heavy down pour or prolonged sprinkling, but it can be surprising to find just how dry it is an inch or two down. To test for moisture, dig down through the mulch occasionally to ensure it is moist throughout and not forming a barrier to water. If it has dried out, more watering alone may not make much difference. You may need to physically turn the mulch over, rolling the moisture in, to ensure it begins to absorb moisture again.
- ❖ Plants that have large tops relative to root-ball size are likely to show greater stress when transplanted. These are often the plants supplied for "instant" landscapes. The stress exhibited by plants can be seen in wilting and drooping foliage and in severe cases - leaf fall. To minimise this stress, freshly transplanted plants should be thoroughly wet-up immediately after transplanting and adequate mulch added to preserve the added moisture. Nuway offer a selection of budget to premium mulches to suit your budget and landscape. Postponing thoroughly watering plants until completing the planting of a large number of plants is a recipe for disaster, particularly in hot weather. This is one of the most important factors in ensuring the continued health of your valuable garden.

SAFETY TIPS:

- ❖ **Garden soils naturally contain micro-organisms that may be harmful to your health. Always wear gloves, keep soil damp while in use to prevent excessive dust inhalation, wear a face mask filter if necessary and wash your hands thoroughly after use.**
